Visa & Entry Requirements

Check if your country is eligible for the Visa Waiver Program (VWP). If not, you will need a B-2 Tourist Visa. Apply early and ensure your passport is valid for at least 6 months beyond your planned stay.

Getting Around the USA

Use domestic flights for long distances. Southwest, JetBlue, and Spirit offer affordable fares. Amtrak is ideal for regional East Coast travel. Car rentals are great for exploring nearby cities.

Stay close to the action. Popular options include:

- Miami: Stadium Hotel, Aloft Aventura
- LA: Hilton Pasadena, Courtyard Old Pasadena
